

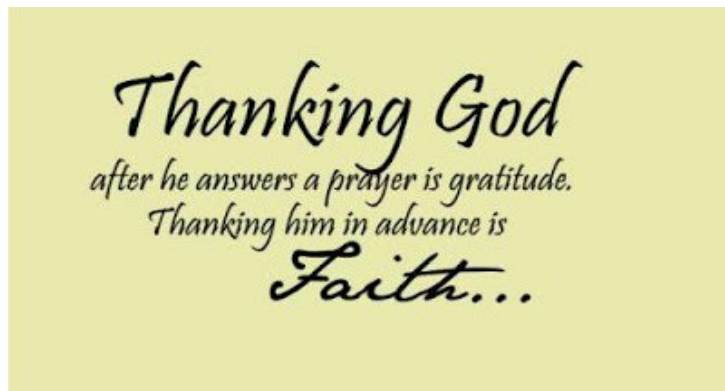

One Bread, One Body - Reflection for November 12, 2017

The Doors



"Open the door." —Matthew 25:11

"The door was barred." —Matthew 25:10

Jesus knocks on the door of our lives. He says: "Here I stand, knocking at the door. If anyone hears Me calling and opens the door, I will enter his house and have supper with him, and he with Me" (Rv 3:20). Jesus wants us to allow Him to know us personally. He wants us even to let Him take over our lives so that we would truthfully and practically say: "It is no longer I that live but Christ Who lives in me" (Gal 2:20, our transl).

There is another door. It is not the door of our lives but the door of eternal life. When Jesus comes for us at our death or at His final coming, He wants to take us through this door into eternal life, love, and happiness with Him. However, we will be able to go through this door only if we have let Jesus know us personally, if we have accepted Him as the Lord of our lives. Otherwise, the door will be barred, and we will hear the eerie, horrifying words of Jesus: "I tell you, I do not know you" (Mt 25:12). Those who are not known by Jesus and do not know Him will be left outside in the darkness of hell where they will wail and grind their teeth forever (Mt 25:30).
